

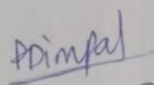
ACTIVITY: TRAINING WORKSHOP ON HIV/AIDS, 4TH AUG, 2022
VENUE: MUMBAI DISTRICT AIDS CONTROL SOCIETY, WADALA (W)

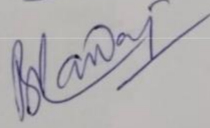

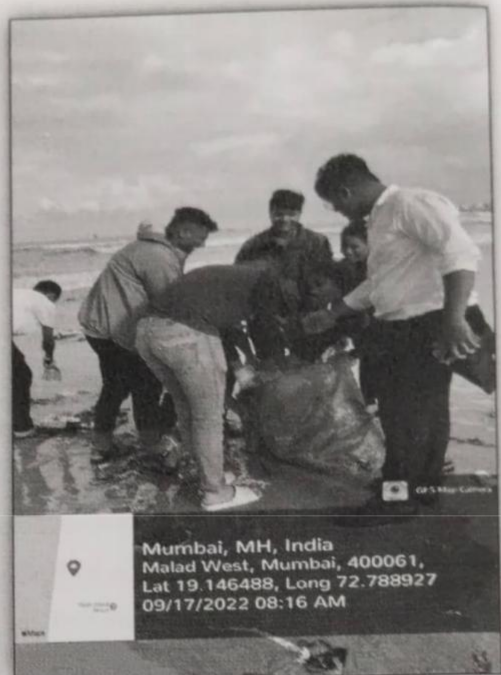

ACTIVITY: PRE DIWALI CELEBRATION WITH OLD AGE HOME, 21ST OCT, 2022

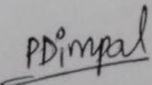
Venue: Sadadevi Foundation Old Age Home, Charkop Sec 9, Kandivali-west.

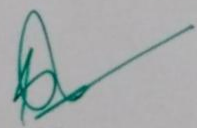
All the lit diya's were kept around the location adding to the beauty of the place in the evening. After some more time spent with them, our volunteers left the old age home at 8:00 PM.

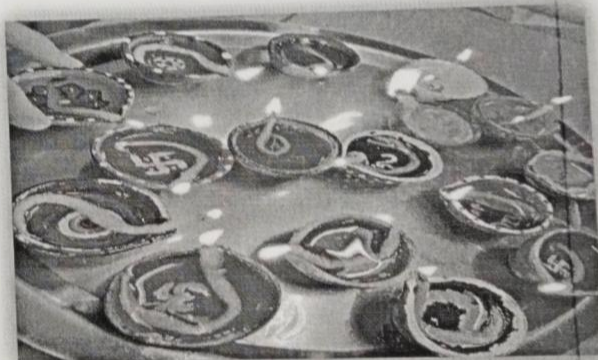

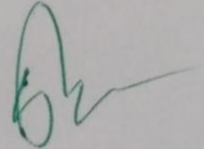
ACTIVITY: BOOK DISTRIBUTION TO KIDS OF ADOPTED AREA, 31ST OCT, 2022

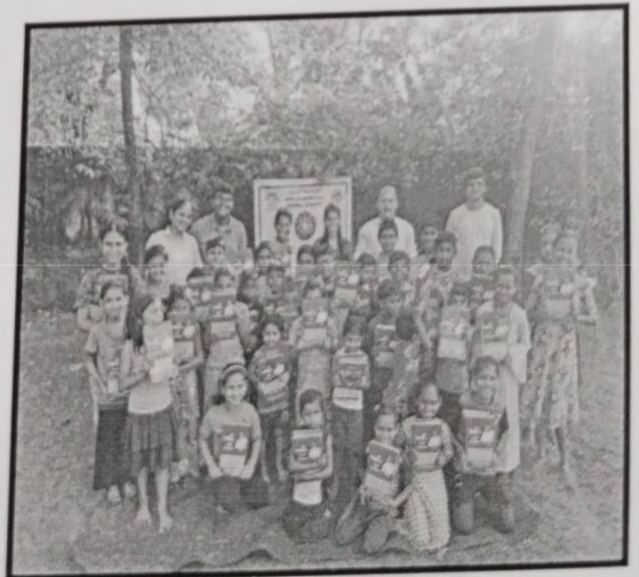
Outcome of the event: Children learn how importance of education and distributed notebooks to them.

➤ **Outcome of the activity:**

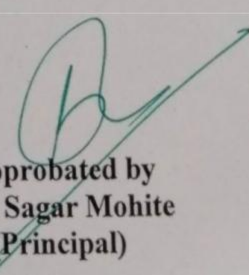

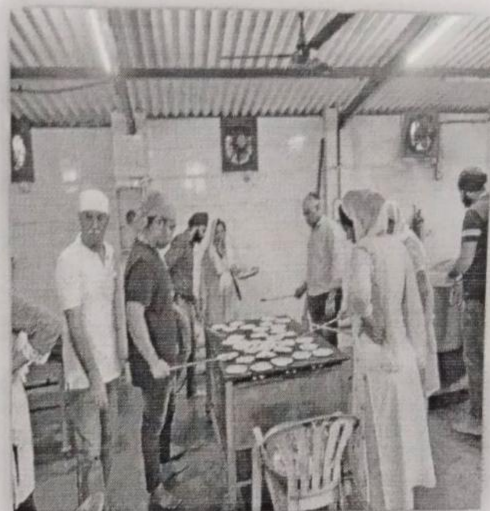

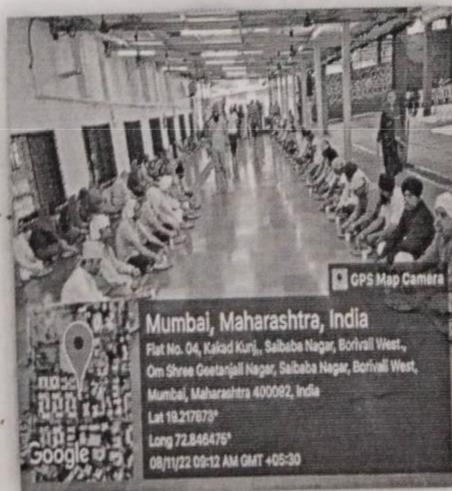

ACTIVITY: CONSTITUTION DAY, 26th NOV, 2022

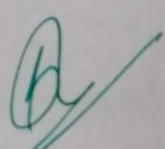
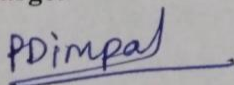
Venue: Crystal Banquet, ACHMCT.

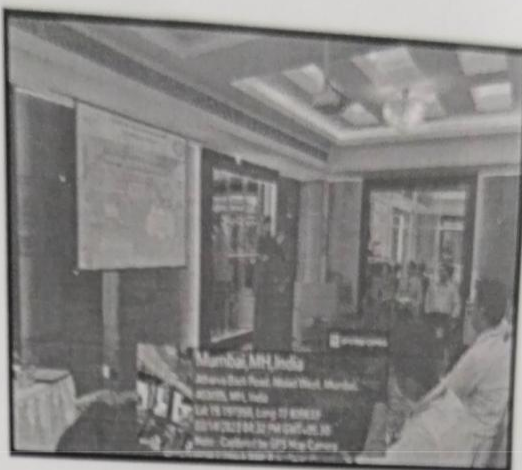

Venue: MANORI BEACH

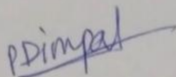

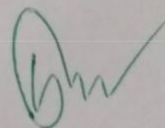
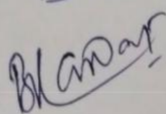
Outcome of the event: Beach cleanups can reduce litter, protect our ocean and raise awareness about litter and plastic pollution.

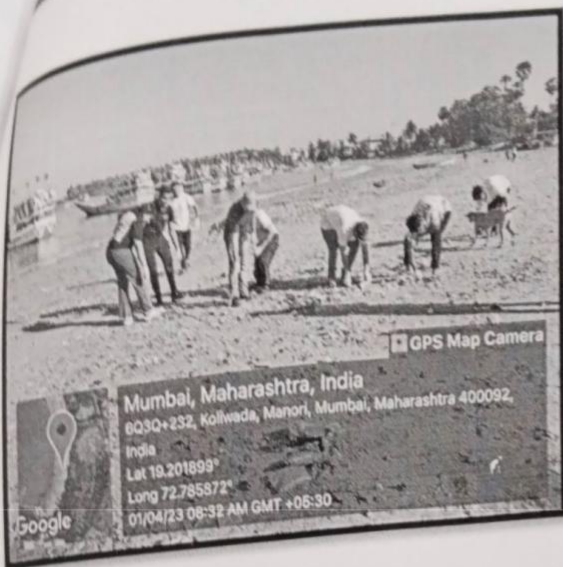
