

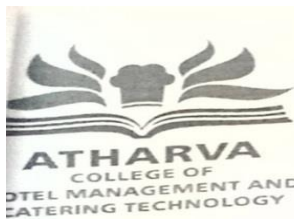

REMEDIAL LECTURES FOR LD STUDENTS

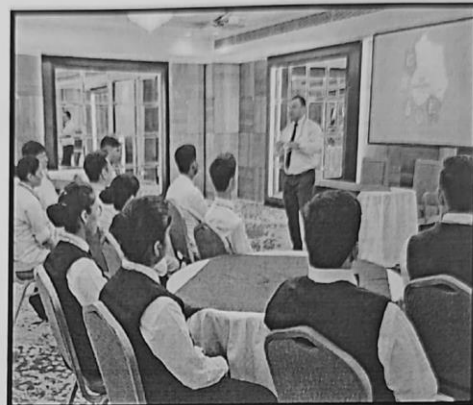
Remedial education, also known as basic skills development, is instruction provided to students who need more support in core areas such as reading, writing and understanding terms of hotel management subjects. These students qualify for remediation because of their low performance in those areas. Remedial teaching has a function to help students to be able to achieve the expected learning outcomes. Broadly speaking, remedial teaching is teaching a repeat of previous teaching primarily on material that has not been mastered.


Steps taken in order to improve their performance:

- Set clear and specific targets (for example: requirement, on the score of dictation and number of assignments)
- Set achievable objectives
- Give diversified rewards (including verbal commendation)
- Review and revise the reward scheme regularly
- Invite parents to help children improve their work.

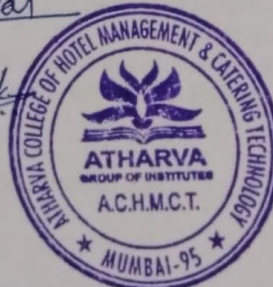

She also emphasized the importance and benefits of Pranayama

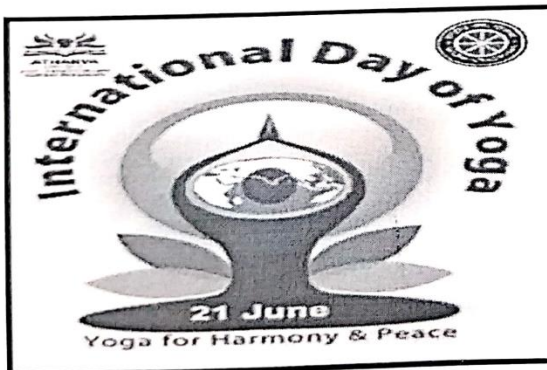
