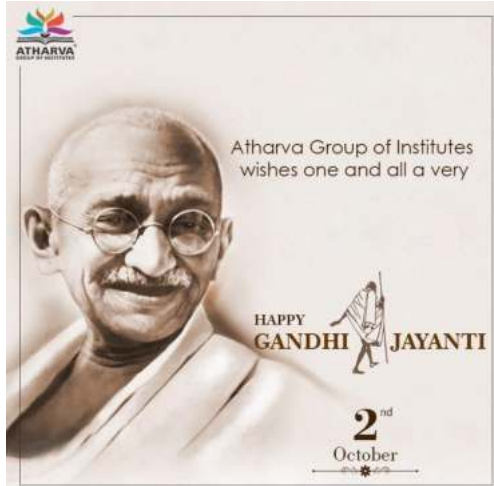


26th January 2019
